



For students interested in creating an Academic Completion Plan within WVU's DegreeWorks system, please follow the instructions below:

1. Direct your browser to mix.wvu.edu and login with your user credentials.
2. Click the "STAR" tab on the upper left portion of the screen.




3. Click "Click here to log into DegreeWorks" on the upper right portion of the screen.




4. Click the "Plans" tab on the upper left portion of the screen.

*The plan created with your assigned academic advisor should be preloaded for you on the screen at this time. You now can create an additional plan that is most specific to your desired discipline within engineering.




To create the additional, discipline specific, plan:

1. Click “New Plan” on the upper right portion of the screen.



2. Click “Select Template”.
3. In the top left corner, you will find a search box. Type in the title of the discipline you are most interested in and click “Go”.



4. Select the description that most closely defines your selection. Be sure to select the “UG” level, and catalog year that is equal to the year you entered WVU. For students that began during the Fall 2015 semester, the catalog year is 1516. For example, a student interested in Industrial Engineering that began in the Fall of 2015, he/she should select Industrial Engineering, UG, catalog year 1516. Once selected, click the “Open” button.

5. Students will be prompted to select the “starting term” for the new plan. Here, a student should select the term that he/she will move into the major. During advising appointments, advisors will discuss the process to move into a discipline major and can guide you as to which term will be the “starting term” in your specific selected engineering major.
6. Once the plan is created, it can be saved by clicking “Save” at the bottom right portion of the screen.
